Congratulations on winning your district!! California District 6 Little League and North Natomas Little League are excited to welcome you, your players, coaching staff and families to the Capital Section Little League 10-11-12 Division Softball tournament scheduled from June 25 - June 29, 2026.

Location: North Natomas Regional Park, 2501 New Market Dr, Sacramento, CA 95835

Arrival: For your first game, please arrive 75-90 minutes prior to game time and 60-75 minutes prior to game time for each subsequent game.

Parking: There is usually plenty of parking in the ball field parking lots, however, if the lot is full overflow parking is at Inderkum high school directly across the street.

Bathrooms: Yes

Snackbar: Yes

Field Amenities: Scoreboard and Lights

Park Amenities: Right next to the softball field there is a playground with swings and a splash pad.

Shade: There is shade should you choose to sit along the 1st and 3rd base lines (bring chairs). If you want to sit closer to the action there are uncovered bleachers, pop ups are welcome.

Play: All games are neutral, home and away will be determined by a coin toss done by the tournament or facilities director prior to each game. The home team will occupy the third base dugout, the away team will occupy the first base dugout. There will be no warming up on the playing field. The tournament director will assign space for your team to warm up upon arrival. Prior to each game both teams will be granted 10 minutes for infield and outfield on the playing field.

Dress Code: NorCal Dress Code will be enforced and all teams are expected to abide by it. Any violation of the code may be cause for removal.

Seeds: North Natomas Regional Park does not allow seeds in the dugout. (clogs the drains.)
